- 1. Total GRIP Grant amount: 200,000 JPY for this 2022 academic year.

Undergraduate and Post Graduate students can apply having 70% marks in previous examination. In the CGPA system a student must obtain above 7 out of 10



Based on the above criteria students are shortlisted. They have to undergo through a personal interaction. (PI)



Personal Interaction conducted by Institute selection committee in which: student's co-curricular, extra-curricular, English Language proficiency (communication skills) and any other achievement will be judged and scoring will be given as per the criteria and students are selected.



Selected students have to undergo personal interaction organised by SCIE selection committee and final list will be prepared by SCIE.



SCIE sends the final lists of students to the director of the institute and subsequently the list will go to Chiba University

Faculty (Dr. S.G. Joshi, Director SCON) will be accompanying students on GRIP study tour, will be getting funding for flight, accommodation and diem through the grant

Post Selection Process

- 1. Final list of students nominated to be sent to SCIE by Dec 15, 2022.
- 2. Both Universities will help/ support students for VISA and documents required for VISA.
- 3. SCIE will check and confirm VISA type for SIU students
- 4. SCIE will organize survival Japanese-speaking sessions (10 hours) for selected SIU students.
- 5. Selected SCON students will participate as buddies for Chiba students during their visit to SIU in Feb 2023.
- 6. The visit for this Academic Year is planned from Feb 28, 2023 to March 10, 2023 for Indian students going to Japan.
- 7. Students from Japan will be visiting India from Feb 13, 2023 to Feb 25, 2023.
- 8. Ms. Kshipra and Ms. Bhakti will be working on Day to Day expenses of the student in Japan and will convey it to SCON.

- Post Learning (min 6 hours) presentations on the learning outcomes and sharing of experiences

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Academic and Research Collaboration Between CHIBA UNIVERSITY, Japan And SYMBIOSIS INTERNATIONAL (DEEMED UNIVERSITY), India

1 Introduction

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as the "MOU") is made and executed on this 1st day of September 2022

between

CHIBA UNIVERSITY

a University established under the School Education Act (Act No. 26 of 1947, enforced on 1st day of April, 1947), and National University Corporation Law (Act No. 112 of 2003, enacted on July 16, 2003), and having its address at: 1-33, Yayoi-cho, Inage-ku, Chiba-shi, Chiba 263-8522 (Japan)

AND

SYMBIOSIS INTERNATIONAL (DEEMED UNIVERSITY)

a University established under Section 3 of the UGC Act 1956 and having address at: Symbiosis Knowledge Village, Gram: Lavale, Taluka: Mulshi, District: Pune 411042 (India), for and on behalf of its Department the Symbiosis Centre for International Education (SCIE), having its campus at: Senapati Bapat Road, Pune 411 004 Through its Registrar

(hereinafter referred to as "SCIE") OF THE SECOND PART

[It is clearly and distinctly understood and acknowledged that this MOU has been executed by Symbiosis International (Deemed University) [SIU], on behalf of Symbiosis Centre for International Education [SCIE], one of its Departments. Therefore, all the rights and obligations as provided in this MOU shall be exercised / performed by SCIE on behalf of SIU and hence SIU in this MOU hereafter be construed as SIU/SCIE].

Symbiosis Centre for International Education (SCIE) is a Department of Symbiosis International (Deemed University) and is engaged in providing leadership and support to internationalize the campus and the curricula. International students from over 85 countries pursue their undergraduate and postgraduate studies at Symbiosis and SCIE aims to provide the students and faculty with opportunities to pursue their international academic interests to the fullest, be it through academic exchanges, or exposure to international conferences, seminars, workshops, and other resources;

2 Scope

The scope of collaboration on academic and research activities in this MOU includes the following categories:

- Academic and research collaboration in the areas of mutual interest.
- Exchange of academic information, scholarly information, materials and publications.
- Exchange of students and faculty.
- Sponsorship of cooperative seminars, workshops and other academic meetings.
- Other activities mutually agreed upon by the two institutions.

2.1 Academic and research collaboration in the areas of mutual interest

Both institutions seek to facilitate research collaboration between their faculty through sharing of research ideas, data, and academic resources that could lead to joint publications. Such opportunities may include joint research conferences, visitations and sabbaticals at each other's institution.

Faculty from both institutions will collaborate in the supervision of exchange students and in joint research in disciplines of mutual interest. All such joint research activities will be governed by the terms laid out in **Annexure 1**.

2.2 Exchange of academic information, scholarly information, materials and publications

Faculty from both institutions may exchange academic information (scholarly information, materials and publications etc).

2.3 Exchange of students and faculty

2.3.1 Student Exchange Programs

Both parties will seek to develop programs whereby their students have the opportunity to study at the other party's university with mutual recognition of the credit hours arising therefrom. Pursuant to the agreement for academic exchange, Chiba University, Japan and Symbiosis International (Deemed University), India will exchange students according to the terms laid out in **Annexure 2**. It is desired by both parties that there will be significant flow of students in both directions. Both institutions may facilitate internship facilities for exchange students provided there are no legal restrictions. It is distinctively understood between the parties that this arrangement between the two parties is restricted to academic and cultural exchanges between students, faculty, staff and is not to be construed or read to be intended for offering any academic awards including Degree/Diploma.

2.3.2 Short Courses/ Summer School — These courses, usually two to four weeks in duration, will normally be held in spring or summer. The programs will facilitate visits by students and faculty to learn about the business environment, culture and any other fields in the host country. In addition to various topics on business operations, culture and any other fields, the course would include meetings with business executives, and visits to various industrial and business establishments. The cost of such programs can be worked out separately each year, since they would be held in addition to the regular semester teaching.



2.3.3 Exchange of Faculty

Both parties agree to develop opportunities for faculty to teach courses or conduct seminars at each other's location. Visiting faculty will be provided with opportunities to observe and share teaching methods and curricula.

Faculty members shall remain on the payroll of their home universities while teaching or researching at the host institutions. Both institutions assist each other in the necessary formalities for obtaining access to national or international scholarship funds.

2.4 Sponsorship of cooperative seminars, workshops and other academic meetings.

Both universities will try to enhance the collaboration by sponsorship of cooperative seminars, workshops and other academic meetings if specific grants are available.

3. Commencement, renewal, termination and amendment

This MOU will come into force upon affixing of the signatures of the representatives of the partner institutions and will remain in effect for **five (5) years**. This MOU may be renewed upon its expiry, with the agreement of both partner institutions.

If either partner institution wishes to terminate the MOU at the end of the five (5) years period it must notify the other institution not less than six (6) months prior to the expiry of the MOU.

This MOU or its renewal and the actions taken under it may be reviewed at any time. Modifications may be made by mutual agreement and any amendment or extension to the MOU may be formalized by the exchange of letters between the two parties.

4. Nature of this MOU

This MOU shall not bind either institution to any financial commitment.

Annexure 1

- 1. Proposals for collaborative research work under this MOU will be submitted with the prior approval of the head of each institution, or his / her nominee.
- 2. Each institution will nominate one of its members as its representative in charge of the cooperative program. Individual programs of work under this MOU will be jointly planned and conducted by the nominees of both parties.
- 3. Progress of work of any individual program will be reviewed and approved by designated authorities of both parties.
- 4. The final approval of any project will depend on the availability of guaranteed support funds.
- 5. Neither Chiba University nor Symbiosis International (Deemed University) will be held responsible for any liability to the other party, and neither party shall be required to purchase any insurance against loss or damage to any property due to activities to which this MOU relates.

Every collaboration will have its own agreement / contract which address issues such as Intellectual Property Right, funding pattern, disclosure of information etc.



Annexure 2

General Guidelines

- 1. This Annexure covers the exchange of undergraduate and graduate students which will occur on a regular basis.
- 2. Exchange students from each university will be permitted to take courses on credit / audit, as well as participate in research activities / project work at the other university. Both institutions agree to only accept students who do not seek degrees at the host university.
 - In any case, the consent of the teacher / project supervisors / research supervisors is required. Such consent will take into account among other things whether the student has pre-requisites for the course / project.
- 3. Suitable candidates for exchange programs will be nominated by the home institution. The host institution will review their academic records and nominations to determine their eligibility for a particular program.
- 4. Prospective exchange students must satisfy the language proficiency requirements of their course of studies, and must have completed at least one (1) year of continuous study at the home institution before being admitted to the exchange program. Prospective exchange students who apply to study at the graduate level must have completed at least one (1) semester of graduate studies before being admitted to the exchange program. Exchange students are expected to return to the home institution upon completion of the exchange program.
- 5. Neither institution will require admission, registration or tuition fees to be paid by exchange students under this MOU. Exchange students will however pay for all other expenses.
- 6. Course credits and grades earned will be determined by the home institution based on the grade report from the host institution.
- 7. Each institution will accept up to 6 students each year. Both institutions will review the program annually for any imbalances in the number of exchange students and make an effort to maintain a reasonable balance in the number of exchange students. Both institutions will endeavor to make the number of exchange students equal by the end of the MOU.
- 8. Participants may not spend more than one year, normally, in the exchange programme.
- 9. Participants will be subjected to the rules and regulations of the host institution, in addition to specific rules and regulations, if any, of the host country regarding foreign students studying in the host country.
- 10. Participants will normally join at the commencement of the semester if they plan to take course.
- 11. Where the exchange student is pursuing a research or implementation project as part of the postgraduate degree program of home institution, the host institution will provide a suitable faculty member to jointly assist (along with the supervisor in the parent institution) the exchange student in formulating research project or jointly supervising the exchange student in the event that a research project has already been identified.
- 12. Each institution will, within the limits of their resources, assist exchange students covered under the terms of this agreement in securing accommodations and in achieving their study and research goals.

- 13. The host institution will inform the home institution of any academic or other problems that may arise during the period of student's residence in the host institution. The host institution will take appropriate action under its established policy and procedures, in consultation with the home institution to deal with such problems.
- 14. The students from Chiba University will have to pay the SCIE administrative charges for transcripts, medical check up, airport pickup, welcome kit, Insurance Charges which are compulsory. The students from Symbiosis International (Deemed University) will have to pay the fee for the National Health Insurance, the Personal Accident Insurance for Students Pursuing Education and Research (Gakkensai) and Comprehensive Insurance for Students Lives Coupled with Gakkensai (Inbound Futai-Gakusou), which are compulsory.

Selection Process

- 1. Students interested in applying for the exchange program are required to
 - [From CU to SIU/SCIE] Apply to the International Students Division at Chiba University with
 - o Curriculum Vitae along with the photograph.
 - Letter from the home institution that the students have been selected to do the course at the partner university.
 - O Two recommendation letters from the faculty members of the institution where the applicant is studying. The faculty will take into account among other things, whether the student has pre requisites for the course / project.
 - Statement of objectives of the student and a specific outline of the programme of study at the host institution, keeping in mind the number of credits required by the home institution.
 - o Photocopy of the Passport.
 - Transcripts from the home institution about the courses which the students have already undertaken.
 - o Proof of competency in English.
 - O An undertaking from the student that he / she has understood the terms and conditions, rules as well as the credit evaluation.
 - [From SIU to CU] Apply to International Students Office at Symbiosis International (Deemed University). The application documents for Chiba University will vary depending on the program.
- 2. The home institution will forward the nominations, if it considers the student suitable for the proposed program. When nominations are forwarded it is presumed that the home institution consents to send the student if selected by the host institution.
- 3. The host institution will evaluate the nominations and determine their suitability for selection under the student exchange program.
