



Here are a few ways by which you can practice respiratory hygiene and avoid spreading the infection, in case you are sick-

Cover your mouth

Always cover your mouth while you sneeze or cough. The best way to cough or sneeze is by covering your mouth with your bent elbow. Avoid using a handkerchief as it becomes a place for breeding bacteria and virus. Use tissues

Maintain distance

whenever someone cough or sneezes, a few droplets escapes their mouth or nose which might contain the virus. If you are standing close to that person, you might contract the virus as the droplets fight fall on you, making you sick later.

The best way to avoid this situation is to maintain a distance of at least 1 meter from anyone in a crowded place. If you are suffering from cough or cold, you must wear a mask in order to avoid spreading it.

Avoid touching mouth and nose



In order to protect yourself from COVID-19, you should consciously avoid touching your mouth, nose or eyes. Wash your hands at regular intervals throughout the day.


