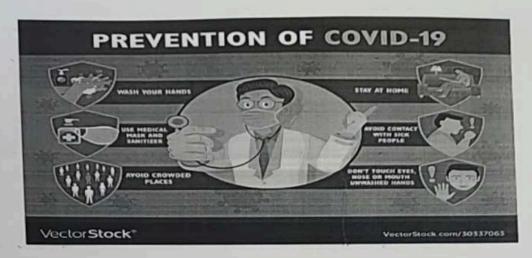

But the coronavirus might also travel through tiny aerosol particles that can linger for up to 3 hours and travel farther away. This is why wearing a facial covering can be important. It can keep you from giving it to others as well as helping you avoid breathing it in.

To prevent the spread of COVID-19:--Clean your hands often. Use soap and water, or an alcohol-based hand rub. Maintain a safe distance from anyone who is coughing or sneezing.

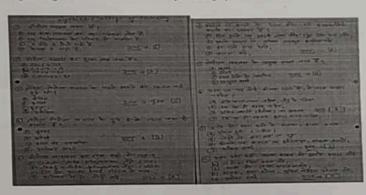
Wear a mask when physical distancing is not possible. Don't touch your eyes, nose or mouth.

Cover your nose and mouth with your bent elbow or a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Stay home if you feel unwell. If you have a fever, cough and difficulty breathing, seek medical attention.

Although the vaccination started but with an average of 34,30,502 anti-coronavirus doses being given per day, India has topped globally in terms of the number of jabs administered daily, the Union health ministry said on first week of march.
