
The program was ended by presenting a vote of thanks to the visitors. Appreciation to the students were done by the people.



The program was ended by presenting a vote of thanks to the community. Appreciation to the students were done by the community people. It was indeed an event which raised awareness among the people about suicide prevention.







PREAMBLE World Hand washing Day

World Hand washing Day, which takes place on October 15 every year, is a day of campaigning throughout the world intended to raise public awareness of the value of using soap and water to wash hands to prevent disease and save lives.

The World Hand washing Association established World Hand washing Day as a chance to develop and put into practice original strategies for inspiring people to cleanse their hands using soap, particularly in times of need.

In 2008, the inaugural World Hand washing Day was observed. Since then, this day has been utilised to raise awareness of the need of having clean hands among both rural and urban population. This is an extremely important message, hand washing is such a basic habit, yet it can actually change everything and save lives.

Why washing hands is important?

One of the easy habits that can actually protect you and your dear ones from a variety of illnesses is washing your hands. During the course of the day at work, many germs are accumulated in our fingernails, nail beds, and between our fingers. Numerous illnesses are caused by these bacteria because they multiply and are consumed.

Contact with an infected individual can result in the transmission of a variety of infectious illnesses, including COVID-19 infections and respiratory and gastrointestinal infections. The proper use of soap and water for hand washing eliminates and destroys germs from our hands and stops the spread of germs from one person to another.

The bacteria and pathogens that cause sickness are eliminated from our hands by hand sanitizers. When we unintentionally touch our eyes, nose, or mouth with contaminated hands, the disease-causing bacteria can spread from infected individuals or from contacting the infected surface.

Both healthy individuals and those with compromised immune systems can avoid diseases by properly washing their hands under running water and soap. You may avoid respiratory illnesses like pneumonia and gastrointestinal infections that cause diarrhoea by washing your hands often. For certain people, including older adults, persons with compromised immune systems, infants, and children, many of these illnesses can be deadly. Even if you are healthy, you can spread these infections.

PREAMBLE World Aids Day

What is World AIDS Day?

World AIDS Day takes place on 1 December each year. It's an opportunity for people worldwide to unite in the fight against HIV, to show support for people living with HIV, and to commemorate those who have died from an AIDS-related illness. Founded in 1988, World AIDS Day was the first ever global health day.

Why is World AIDS Day Important?

Over 105,000 people are living with HIV in the UK. Globally, there are an estimated 38 million people who have the virus. Despite the virus only being identified in 1984, more than 35 million people have died of HIV or AIDS related illnesses, making it one of the most destructive pandemics in history.





The theme of World TB Day 2023 - 'Yes! We can end TB!' conveys a message of hope that getting back-on-track to turn the tide against the TB epidemic is possible through high-level leadership, increased investments, faster uptake of new WHO recommendations and adoption of innovations, accelerated action and multisectoral collaboration.

The first World TB Day was observed in 1983, with the theme "Defeat TB: Now and Forever". Since then, the day has been marked every year with a new theme that focuses on a specific aspect of the global fight against TB. The theme for World Tuberculosis Day 2023 is "Yes! We can end TB!" which aims to inspire and encourage high-level leadership, increased investments, faster uptake of new WHO recommendations, adoption of innovations, accelerated action, and multisectoral collaboration to fight the Tuberculosis epidemic.

2023 is a critical year to push forward the agenda toward ending TB, as there are several high-level opportunities to raise visibility, increase political commitment, and enhance investments for the TB response. Heads of State will come together to deliberate on accelerating efforts to end TB, for the second time at the 2023 UN High-Level Meeting on TB at the General Assembly in September. The UN High-Level Meeting on TB will be held alongside two other high-level meetings focusing on UHC and pandemic preparedness. There are clear linkages between all three agendas. The prioritization of TB in the agenda of Heads of State and other leaders provides a strong impetus to step up progress against this ancient disease.

This year the spotlight of World TB Day will be on urging countries to ramp up progress in the lead-up to the 2 Jead-up to the 2023 UN High-Level Meeting on TB. WHO will also issue a call to action with Dartners urging Member States to accelerate the rollout of the new WHO-recommended shorter treatment

all-oral treatment regimens for drug-resistant TB.
