The workshop is particularly relevant for Institutional Research Committee (IRC) members from all institutes under Symbiosis. Therefore, we recommend that their participation be mandated.



CONCEPT NOTE

Bioethics is a dynamic area having various dimensions from maintaining confidentiality of the data, informed consents to good clinical practice in research studies. The ethical practice in research can be continued by regular and repeated sensitization and time-to-time updating of knowledge of the researchers as well as the regulating bodies like Ethics Committees. The concerns and issues about the ethical dilemmas are a constant scenario during the conduct and review of biomedical research and they need to be addressed to protect the rights and safety of the research participants involved in clinical research.

This workshop aims to discuss and update the knowledge of the Ethics Committee members, faculties, students, PhD Scholars & researchers at SIU; and about selected topics in health research ethics. It will serve as a training activity for the members of the IECs of SIU. The workshop will be very useful for all participants to get introduced to the ethics related information and procedures.

This workshop will introduce the participants to general principles and issues in ethics with reference to the 'New Drugs & Clinical Trial Rules 2019' & 'ICMR National Ethical Guidelines for Biomedical & Health Research, 2017'.
